# **Customer Origin Responsibilities (Pre-Pickup)**

# Double-Check Your Home

- ★ Ensure your residence and/or pickup location is tidy and all items are free of soil, mold, and pests. This includes all outdoor items such as playsets and grills.
- ★ Pre-inspect all property for Spotted Lanternfly and Spongy Moth. A formal inspection between you and your service provider will take place during pickup.
- ★ Remove items from your attic, crawl space, or other areas that lack a finished floor, adequate lighting, or sufficient space to stand upright. Service provider personnel are not required to enter these areas.

# Identify and Clean

- ★ Create a "Do Not Take" area and clearly mark items that you do not want moved. Identify and separate your Professional Books, Papers, & Equipment (PBP&E/"Pro-Gear") from other property.
- ★ Empty, defrost, and clean the inside your refrigerator/freezer at least three days before your move. Leave the doors open afterward to allow them to dry.
- ★ Ensure dishes are clean and ready to be packed.
- ★ Remove garbage from all trash cans in your residence prior to pack/load dates.

## Disconnect Appliances and TVs

- ★ Disconnect all appliances including washers, dryers, stoves, and refrigerators. If you are moving a front-load washer, obtain the manufacturer-provided bolts to secure the drum for movement.
- ★ Unmount and disconnect all TVs and satellite dish(es). It is your responsibility to reconnect these items at the destination.
- ★ Original manufacturer boxes provide added protection for TVs and monitors. Please notify your movers if you still have these boxes available for reuse during shipping.

### **Prepare Special and Unique Items**

- ★ If you own antiques or other high-value items, it is recommended that you obtain an appraisal prior to pickup. The government does not pay for appraisals, but you should consider this part of your investment in the event of loss or damage.
- ★ Some complex furniture or equipment may require customer disassembly. If you own any of the items below, be sure to identify them during your pre-move survey to discuss your responsibilities:
  Peloton, treadmill, elliptical, home gym, squat rack, bunk beds
- ★ If shipping engine-powered equipment (e.g., motorcycles, dirt bikes, lawnmowers, snowmobiles, mopeds, boats), ensure they are clean and free of dirt, grease, and fully drained of fuel before pickup.

## **Other Important Steps**

- ★ Plan to keep your children and pets in a safe area away from high-traffic zones during packing and loading.
- ★ You may take photos/videos of your property to record its condition prior to pickup. Please ensure a date stamp is visible.
- ★ You may also create a personal inventory of the items being moved. However, note that this personal list will not be used for claims purposes.
- ★ Movers have the right to repack any item(s) they believe require additional protection. This includes items packed in plastic tubs and totes. All pre-packed containers must be opened for inspection/inventory purposes.
